Pushkar Maitra is currently Professor of Economics in the Department of Economics at Monash University. Maitra completed his Ph.D. in Economics from the University of Southern California in 1997. Since the completion of his Ph.D., he has held positions at the University of Sydney (1997 – 2000) and at Monash University (2000 onwards). He is one of the leading Development Economists in Australia. His specific research interests are analysis of poverty and welfare in developing countries; health, education and human capital accumulation; fertility, mortality and gender preference with special focus on South Africa and South Asia. He has published extensively and in reputed international journals. While the majority of his research involves the study of household behaviour in developing countries using economic theory and econometric analysis, some of his more recent research deals with the application of econometric techniques in fields as diverse as Experimental Economics, Health Economics and Law and Economics.
