In this regard, the following are the terms and conditions for appointment of foreign coaches.

- 1. Development of Indian players and training of attached Indian coaches.
- 2. The agreement will be for a period of 2 years initially and reviewed every two years and extendable up to 2020 Olympics on the basis of the performance of the coach and a team/individual.
- 3. Salary of a foreign coach will be up to a maximum of Rs.2.5 lakhs per month negotiable subject to his qualification, experience and achievements. Payment will be 60% in USD and 40% will be in Indian currency.
- 4. Expenses of medical treatment of a coach, once spouse and one child through mediclaim policy of Rs. 2 lakhs for each person.
- 5. General Insurance cover will be to the extent of Rs.10 lakhs against accidental, damage/death and working hazards.
- 6. Air passage will be in economy class for each member as mentioned in para-4 of above.
- 7. The excess Personal baggage up to 40 kg. and limited up to 120 kg. Extra baggage for entire (3) family plus airport taxes.
- 8. Leave up to 30 days per annum on pro-rata basis.
- 9. He will be provided furnished accommodation.
- 10. Transport (including travel and technical services) for official purpose visit to a hospital in case of illness and once in a week for marketing.
- 11. Sports kit to the coach will be provided once in a year.
- 12. Transportation and free boarding and lodging facilities will be provided on official trips.
- 13. Initially, he will be on probation for a period of 3 months. Preference will be given to the coach from the Govt. agency, if any.
